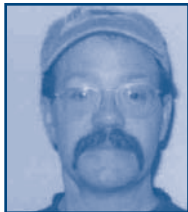

## GENERAL RULES

- All parties participating at Montana State Fair Events are responsible for reading the **General Information & Montana Department of Livestock Health, Brand and Import** sections of this handbook and complying with the policies listed therein.
- No entry will be considered complete unless accompanied by appropriate entry fees. **Late entries are subject to double entry fees on a space available basis.**
- Each exhibitor shall purchase admittance tickets. A \$15 season ticket that will admit one person plus vehicle is available. Exhibitors 6-18 years may purchase a \$10 season ticket that will admit one for the week, no vehicles. State Fair will provide one additional season admission ticket for each \$50 of entry fees.
- AGREEMENT TO ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS HEREIN STATED IS UNDERSTOOD WHEN THE EXHIBITOR SUBMITS THE ENTRY FORM.**

- Use the entry form included in this book to enter poultry divisions. Additional forms can be obtained from Montana State Fair by calling 727-8900 or by duplicating form in book. Entry forms and fees may be delivered to State Fair administration office, open weekdays 8 am to 5 pm. Mailed entry forms and fees should be sent to: Entry Office, Montana State Fair, PO Box 1888, Great Falls, MT 59403.
- ONE EXHIBITOR PER ENTRY FORM.** All entries must be made in the name of the actual owner of the bird.
- Each entry **MUST BE COMPLETED IN FULL.** Include the class code. Leg band number **MUST** be listed for each individual bird.
- All possible care will be exercised by State Fair in handling exhibits, but no responsibility for loss or damage in transit or during any phase of the exhibit will be assumed by State Fair.
- Any animal showing symptoms of disease shall be removed from the building at once, and cared for by the proper authorities. Cost of vet service will be the responsibility of the exhibitor. A representative from the Montana state livestock sanitary board will be in the building most of the week and will help examine exhibits upon arrival.
- Requirements of the state livestock sanitary board as outlined in Chapter 12, Paragraph 1207, of the State Regulations Governing Poultry Shows will apply in this department, State Fair, being a member of the American Poultry Association, will conduct this show under the latest revised official show rules of this association, and all awards will be made strictly in accordance with the American Standard of Perfection.
- All exhibits must be examined by the superintendent before being allowed in the exhibition building.
- All exhibits will be cooped under the superintendent's supervision and no exhibit may be removed from cages or handled in any manner by an unauthorized person except by special permission of the superintendent. **This rule will be strictly adhered to.**
- There will be no signs allowed on the coops at any time.
- All entries will be fed and cared for by the superintendent and staff.
- Entries may be shipped to Montana State Fair with prior notification to the superintendent on arrival time. Shipping crates must be plainly marked "for exhibition," Montana State Fair, Great Falls, MT 59404. All shipping fees must be prepaid by exhibitor. Exhibits will be picked up and delivered from shipping station at no additional cost.
- Note:** the superintendent will handle sale of any stock offered at no charge. Exhibits offered for sale must list sale prices on the entry form.

### Montana State Fair - Show #2 APA Sanctioned

- Send completed entry form and remit entry fee to Montana State Fair, Box 1888, Great Falls, MT 59403. Designate on entry, SHOW #2.
- Ribbons and sanction points offered by this show. No premiums.

## REGULATIONS FOR SECTIONS 2-9:

- Completed entry forms, one per exhibitor, and entry fees made payable to Montana State Fair.
- There will be a \$.50 Charge for each change made on entry form on check in day. Not listing band #'s will constitute a change.
- Substitutions will be allowed only if replacement bird is of the same breed, variety, age and sex as previous entry.
- All birds must have leg bands to identify individuals. Leg bands may be purchased at state fair entry office for \$.25 And \$.50 Each.
- Exhibitors are asked to dust their bird's 7 days prior to check in day at the fair.
- Handsome ribbons will be awarded in all regular classes on 1st thru 5th placings.

## STANDARD/BANTAM POULTRY

- All poultry will be judged in accordance with the current American Poultry Association Standard Of Perfection, copyrighted by the American Poultry Association.
- To win American Poultry Association medals there must be 10 entries in each class. Competition is open to all entries, however, APA awards will be issued only to those winners who are members in good standing.
- To become a member of APA - adults send \$10 for 1 year or \$25 for 3 years and juniors (under 18 years of age) send \$5 for 1 year to: American Poultry Association, c/o Lorna Rhodes, Secretary-treasurer, 133 Millville St, Mendon, MA 01756.

**BANTAM POULTRY**

- a. Only members of the aba are eligible for aba awards. Winners of aba awards are listed in the yearbook under who's who in bantams. Starred wins are earned by champions and reserve champions when the number of birds in the class is 100 or more. For definition of class see the following listing:
  1. 7 x 9 plaque for champion and reserve champion of show.
  2. 5 x 7 plaque for best and reserve of class in classes of 50 or more birds competing.
  3. Certificates for best and reserve of class in classes of 25 - 49 birds competing.
- b. To join the ABA remit \$15 for one year (individual or family) or \$40 for three years. Those joining for one year get a free copy of the latest yearbook which features about 800 advertisers plus a complete breed and variety index. Send to: american bantam association, c/o Karen Unrath, Sec. PO Box 127, Augusta, NJ 07822.
- c. A single bird cannot get more than one starred win at any one show, likewise a single bird is limited to winning one plaque - for example, should best feather leg be grand champion only one plaque will be issued to it.
