GENERAL RULES: (both shows)

- All parties participating at Montana State Fair Events are responsible for reading the **General Information & Montana Department of Livestock Health, Brand and Import** sections of this handbook and complying with the policies listed therein.
- No entry will be considered complete unless accompanied by appropriate entry fees. **Late entries are subject to double entry fees on a space available basis.**
- Each exhibitor shall purchase admittance tickets. A \$15 season ticket includes 10 adult admissions and/or a vehicle. Exhibitors 6-18 years may purchase a \$10 season ticket that includes 10 admissions--no vehicle. State Fair will provide one additional season admission ticket for each \$50 of entry fees.
- AGREEMENT TO ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS HEREIN STATED IS UNDERSTOOD WHEN THE EXHIBITOR SUBMITS THE ENTRY FORM.**
- Use the entry form included in this book to enter miniature horse divisions. Additional forms can be obtained from Montana State Fair by calling 727-8900 or by duplicating form in book. Entry forms and fees may be delivered to State Fair administration office, open weekdays 8 am to 5 pm. Mailed entry forms and fees should be sent to: Entry Office, Montana State Fair, 400 3rd St NW, Great Falls, MT 59404.
- All possible care will be exercised by State Fair in handling exhibits, but no responsibility for loss or damage in transit or during any phase of the exhibit will be assumed by State Fair.
- IMMEDIATELY UPON ARRIVAL**, exhibitors or individuals should report for assignment of stalls. Space will be assigned in order that entries are received. No horses or equipment to be at fairgrounds before Friday, July 29, without prior approval. Tack stalls will be given if possible. **Decorations are encouraged** for stall and tack areas. Stabling provided for exhibited horses only. **A \$5 stall fee will be accessed.** NO entry shall be entitled to stable space nor admitted to the show ring until entry & stall fees are paid. **FEES LISTED MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORMS.**
- No animals will be released before the stated check out time except out of state and Canadian entries. Out of state and Canadian animals will be released at the discretion of the superintendent. Prior arrangements **MUST** be made with the superintendent for all early releases.

- j. **Stall and exhibition spaces MUST be cleaned before 10 am each day of the Fair.** Aisles must be kept free. Please do not block aisles with chairs, equipment, etc.
- k. Registration papers must be available for steward and show management.
- l. In order to qualify for judging, each contestant must appear in the ring wearing the correct number, plainly visible.
- m. Show management reserves the right to reject any entry at any time for disrespect to the rules, intoxication, rough treatment of animals or any other reason he deems reasonable.
- n. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in the AMHR rule books or rules herein, same shall be referred to the show manager. He will make a decision at that time or deem necessary to call together the show committee for a ruling.
- o. All exhibitors should familiarize themselves with the official rule book of the AMHR.
- p. Anyone is eligible to show his horse except the judge, his family or animals that he has in training or just completed training.
- q. Any ties for high point awards will be decided by 1) most number of firsts, 2) most number of seconds or 3) most number of classes entered.



"Little Legends" AMHR Registered Miniature Horse Show

CLASS REGULATIONS:

- a. AMHR rules apply to "Little Legends Show"
- b. All exhibitors should familiarize themselves with the official rule book of the AMHR.
- c. All General Rules of this department apply to this show.
- d. A \$5 stall fee is required. Horses will be stabled in Beef Barn
- e. Open to horses registered with the American Miniature Horse Registry
- f. Any horse that becomes a threat to an exhibitor, audience, or other animal may be asked to be removed from the show grounds.
- g. NO ENTRY REFUNDS will be made without a veterinarian statement.
- h. Checks returned for non-sufficient funds shall incur a \$25 return check fee.
- i. Youth is an exhibitor age 17 and under.
- j. Amateur must possess and show Amateur card. Card may be purchased at show.
- k. Post entries from horses already entered in prior classes will be accepted up to 2 classes prior to class entered.
- l. There will be no post entry fee for this show.
- m. Two Minute Gate Rule: Once a class is called, the gate steward will begin timing for all entries to enter. *There will be no refund for missed classes.* It is the exhibitors responsibility to ensure a class is not missed. Any exhibitor who fails to show an entry will forfeit that entry fee.
- n. Gate-holds must be given to the gate steward 4 classes prior and must be in writing. Gate-holds will be for a maximum of two minutes for in hand classes and five minutes for harness/cart changes.
- o. Wash racks are available.
- p. See **Montana Department of Livestock Health, Brand and Import** sections of this handbook for rules governing this show. All required papers must be received before stalling will be assigned.
- q. Ribbons will be awarded 1st thru 4th place. Classes will be judged to 6 places.

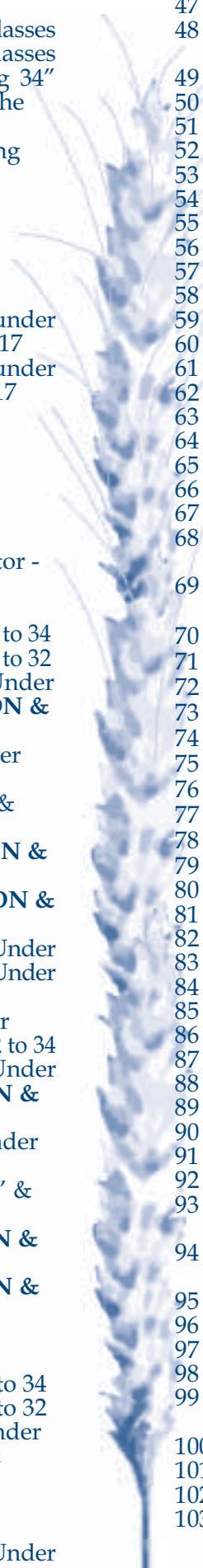

Open Miniature Horse Show

REGULATIONS:

- AMHR rules apply to Open Miniature Horse "Fun Show"
- All General rules of this department apply to this show.
- A \$5 stall fee is required, unless stall fees have previously been paid for the registered show. Horses will be stabled in Beef Barn.
- Open to Miniature Horses 38" and under. Registration papers not mandatory. Horses may be measured at Judge's discretion.
- Any class with less than four entries may be scratched, combined or changed at manager's discretion.
- Two (2) minute gate rule and five (5) minute tack change rule will be enforced. No refunds on classes missed.
- Youth classes are limited to exhibitors 17 years and younger.
- Pleasure Driving - A two wheeled cart with a foot basket. To be shown at a walk, trot, and extended trot.
- Applicable patterns will be posted in the barn.
